






Learning happens on the playground as well as in the classroom.

A safe and well-built playground not only provides an ideal place for children to develop cognitive, socio-emotional and motor development skills but it also engages them in activities that are healthy for the body and mind. To date, we have built 11 playgrounds throughout Serbia, and have plans to build many more in the future.

MindUP is a program that was developed by a team of psychologists, neuroscientists, and educators for the Goldie Hawn Foundation and was designed specifically to help children better understand and regulate their emotions.

MindUP teaches children coping strategies and equips them with practical tools to navigate complex emotional situations.

The program runs concurrently with regular curriculum and enhances a child's holistic educational experience. MindUP has been used with great success in over 20 institutions throughout Serbia so far.



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


Each year, we hold a holiday celebration known as New Year's Presents for more than 600 children in foster care, to remind them that they are loved and wanted.

Working closely with community officials, we select gifts specifically for each child, keeping in mind their unique likes and wants. These celebrations are filled with hope, love, and joy.

Recent studies report that more than 6,000 children throughout Serbia are in foster care. Of that number, more than 800 live in institutionalized care.





Our main focus is on preschool children, but because we believe education and development happen outside of the classroom and beyond primary school, we wanted to find a way to reach older kids, teenagers and students alike in order to motivate them to think courageously and act originally.

We believe that with the proper help, guidance, and motivation, every person can be a future leader in their field.

That's why we launched Original Magazine - to inspire the next generation of movers and shakers to think "outside of the box" and to inspire them to aim for success in all of its many varied forms.







Income from Supporters in 2016




