#### Our results

Since 2007, the Foundation invested over \$ 10 million in early childhood development programs and helped over 20.000 children in Serbia.



# Teacher support


#### Teachers affect the eternity.

They are are instrumental in laying the solid foundation in the lives of our young dreamers. In order to ensure our children's future and success, we are constantly improving and enriching the ways our teachers teach.

Just last year, we trained 346 teachers.

That means that at least 8650 children (around 25 kids per teaching group) will receive a quality education.

#### Support, not Perfection

#### A unique dream to help parents have fun being parents.

In the era of pressure, we are forced to be perfect.

Parents are often feeling cornered by everyone's expectations, and there were few, if any, initiatives that dealt with the problem. So we created one.

Delivered where and when it was really needed, with generous donations from our partners, the **Support, not Perfection** program has covered hundreds of parents so far, and through the parents affected thousands of children. This number is likely to grow fast.

#### Invested so far: \$51,232




#### Friendship Games

Most of the kids who attend **Friendship Games** have never travelled before, or done things they do there: from numerous workshops to swimming or kite flying, or even meeting other children. For them, **Friendship Games** are a week of dreaming with eyes wide open.

From 2013, 405 children and 47 teachers have gone through our Friendship Games camp.

We want children to (re)connect with nature, to fall in love with it, and to know that it holds the key to their healthy (and delicious) growing up. We also want the whole community to help the young ones – that's why we're including their parents and teachers into the project.


3 locations: Belgrade, Svilajnac and Ub 12 gardens planted and maintained by children 12 teachers, 115 parents, 150 children involved in the program

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#### MindUP

"The little things? The little moments? They aren't little."

MindUP was developed by a team of psychologists, neuroscientists, and educators for the Goldie Hawn Foundation, and was designed specifically to help children better understand and regulate their emotions.

MindUP develops children's social and emotional skills, increases the quality of their focus, teaches them stress reduction techniques. It is based on the newest findings in neurosciences and positive psychology.

The effects we see in the participating kindergartens and schools include better peer relations, less peer violence, and better learning outcomes.

So far, 517 teachers trained and 4220 children covered by the program.

In the following year, we plan to open 20 more groups and cover 720 more teachers and over 2500 children.
